

2014 Suitcase Challenge "MINI MODERN"

Thank you for entering The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc Suitcase Challenge. The modern quilt movement is on the rise and with that in mind we are challenging you to make a modern quilt. There is lots of information on the web and we have some new books in the library so start researching. We hope you have some fun with this one!

The conditions listed below are fairly self-explanatory but please feel free to contact us at the Guild office if you have any queries.

Conditions of Entry

- ALL quilts will be retained by The Guild for inclusion in a Suitcase Exhibition, which will
 be available to be borrowed by groups around Australia. The quilts will be returned to the
 quilt makers on completion of their touring schedule (approximately 28 months).
- Entry is limited to individual, financial members of The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc.
- There are no limits to the use of colour or method of construction, but the quilt must have
 3 layers.
- The size of the finished quilt must be **40cms x 40cms** (16 x 16 inches) and may hang in either orientation.
- Embellishments may be added, but should not protrude excessively from the surface and may not extend past the standard size. They must be robustly attached. Any quilts which require special handling will not be accepted.
- A hanging sleeve of at least 6cms depth must be attached to the back of the guilt.
- A label with the quilt name and the makers name and address must be securely attached to the back of the quilt.
- Awards for First and Second place and Viewers' Choice will be made.
- The committee reserves the right to photograph, and permit to be photographed, all items for publicity and publication including on The Guild's website.
- Whilst all due care will be taken, The Guild accepts no responsibility for the safety of the challenge entries. If you wish to insure your quilt, please make your own arrangements.

ALL quilts will be displayed at the AGM of The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc. to be held on Saturday 22th October 2014 at Burwood RSL

Completed guilts are to be sent to the Guild Office by 5th September 2014.
