A juried quilt exhibition organized by The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc. in collaboration with The Hazelhurst Regional Gallery and Art Centre

Two prizes will be offered. First Prize: \$1,500 and Viewer's Choice: \$200

In awarding first prize, judges will carefully consider the appropriate interpretation of the theme and design concepts applied, particularly the use of colour and value

Closing date: 24 July 2015

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The theme of the exhibition is:

‘Evolution, Change, Challenge – A Contemporary Quilt’.
2. Entrants must be a resident of Australia. It is **not** a requirement of entry to be a member of The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc.
3. Each entrant may enter a maximum of two quilts.
4. Each entry must reflect the spirit of the theme.
5. It is a requirement that all quilts be made specifically for this exhibition and completed between December, 2014 and the entry date. The quilt must not have been shown or published in any quilting forum prior to the exhibition.
6. A process diary should be available for exhibition on request.
7. The quilt is to be an original design and the individual entrant's own work. Recognition of any inspiration taken from another work must be acknowledged. It is the responsibility of the quiltmaker to obtain written permission and pay any fee regarding the use of copyright.
8. Any materials or techniques may be used. The quilt must conform to the standard requirements of three layers held together by stitching.
9. Each entry must measure 70cms width by 100cms height to be hung in portrait orientation. A variation of plus or minus 2cm is acceptable.

10. A hanging sleeve with a minimum depth of 8cm must be firmly attached to the top edge of the back of each quilt. Quilts with special hanging requirements will not be accepted.
11. A label stating the entrant's name and full contact details must be securely attached to the back of the quilt.
12. A non-refundable fee of \$25.00 is required for **each** entry. Payment may be made by cheque, credit card or EFT/Direct Deposit. See last page of these conditions.
13. Two high resolution jpeg images of the **completed** quilt must be submitted with each entry:
 - A full image of the work (including edges) and
 - A close-up view showing details of the work

Images must be at least 1200 pixels on the longest side and the file size must not exceed 4MB **each**.

Please name the file with your last name, first initial and the word "full" or "detail".

For example:

- JonesBDetail.jpg

If submitting more than one entry, please add the entry number.

For example:

- JonesBFull2.jpg
- JonesBDetail2.jpg

Please note high quality images are essential as poor photography may result in elimination.

14. Entries must be submitted via online form on The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc website www.quiltersguildnsw.com no later than **24 July, 2015**.
15. From the images submitted, a panel of three jurors will select up to 40 quilts for possible inclusion in the exhibition. Entrants whose quilts have been selected for further consideration will be notified via email by **03 August, 2015**.
16. Each successful entrant must, at their own expense, organize delivery of the quilt to The Guild office to arrive no later than **3.00pm, 14 August, 2015**. Packaging must be clearly marked:

Office hours for delivery of quilts in person or by courier are:
10.00am – 3.00pm Monday to Friday.

Quilts may be either folded or rolled for delivery.

17. Entries that are to be returned by mail must arrive in a sturdy Post Office approved container. The Guild reserves the right to charge the entrant for such a container if it is not provided.

17. From the quilts selected for exhibition, three judges will select the winning quilt. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

18. The exhibition will be held at:

Selected quilts must be available from 14 August 2015 to 14 September 2015

19. At the conclusion of the exhibition, quilts will be available for collection from The Guild office between the hours of 10.00am - 3.00pm from 14 - 18 September, 2015.

Any quilt not collected by 18 September will be returned by Australia Post COD delivery from 21 September, 2015.

20. It will be possible to offer exhibited quilts for sale, subject to 30% Hazelhurst Regional Gallery & Arts Centre commission requirements. Successful entrants will be supplied with further information regarding sale procedures upon notification of acceptance.

21. It is the entrant's responsibility to provide any insurance cover they require.

The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc. and Hazelhurst Regional Gallery & Arts Centre are not liable for any loss, damage or destruction of exhibition items, however such loss, damage or destruction is caused, including any negligent act, or omission, fault or cause.

22. The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc. and Hazelhurst Regional Gallery & Arts Centre reserve the right to photograph your quilt for their records and to use those photographs for promotional and other appropriate purposes such as newsletters, websites and blogs.

The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc and Hazelhurst Regional Gallery and Arts Centre retain copyright in any photographs taken by them.

The entrant retains copyright in their quilt. By entering the competition, the entrant agrees to the The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc. and Hazelhurst Regional Gallery and Arts Centre using their Quiltmaker's Statement from the entry form for the jurying/judging process and publicity/promotional purposes. Images submitted with the entry form will be used for jurying purposes only.

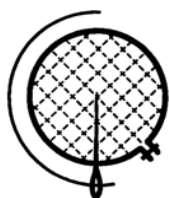
