




SYDNEY QUILT SHOW 2014 ENTRY FORM CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Please read all the conditions carefully
- ♦ Sign the acknowledgement on Entry Form Part A
- Entry to the show is open only to financial members of The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc. The closing date for the return of the Entry Form is Friday 14th March 2014.
- Written acceptance of your quilt(s) will be despatched by 1st May 2014. Delivery and return instructions will also be enclosed.
- Quilts must be delivered to the entrant's designated Drop Off Person by 1st July 2014. Quilts must be collected within seven days post exhibition.
- 4. A non-refundable entry fee of \$25 for up to two entries is required with the Entry Form (except for Categories 16 & 17). Interstate and overseas entrants will be required to pay for return postage. A separate Entry Form Part A (Quilt Details) is required for each quilt to be entered. Only one Entry Form Part B (Payment Details) is required for each entrant entering.
- 5. A maximum of two entries may be submitted however only one may be selected. Acceptance of entry does not automatically guarantee display. If more quilts are accepted than can be displayed the Exhibition Sub-Committee will determine the quilts to be selected. **Please indicate your first preference**. The photograph detailed in Condition 16 may be important in this selection process.
- It is anticipated that every quiltmaker will assist at the show. Please indicate your availability on the enclosed Volunteer Form.
- 7. For the exhibition, a quilt is considered to have at least 3 layers of fabric held together with stitching.
- If your quilt is not to be judged and is entered for display only, please indicate Category '0' NOT TO BE JUDGED under Quilt Details Part A. The quilt still needs to conform to all necessary Conditions (1-11, 16-20, 31-32).
- If the number of entries in any one category is low, the Committee has the right to reduce the number of prizes to be awarded without notice.
- 10. Full details must be supplied and attribution given if your quilt is made in a class or workshop, from a kit, from a publication or a pre-printed whole cloth quilt. You must include reference to all sources of inspiration in the Description of Quilt section of the Entry Form including another quilter's design, a photograph or an artwork regardless of what percentage of your quilt has been influenced. Please include these details in your quilt description for the catalogue.

- 11. It is the responsibility of the quiltmaker to obtain written permission and pay any fee regarding the use of copyright material. A copy of each permission must be attached to the Entry Form.
- The quilt must be the maker's own work including piecing, quilting and binding if entered under one name.
- 13. If a quilt is entered by 2 persons, they must both be members of The Guild and Condition 12 applies to them jointly.
- 14. A group/collaborative (Category 13) quilt is made by three or more people. This includes friendship quilts. At least one person must be a member of the Guild and the quilt entered under that member's name. Groups that hold group membership of the Guild may enter the quilt under the group's name.
- 15. If you enter the Commercially Machine Quilted Quilt Category (Category 14) the Commercial Machine Quilter must be a member of the Guild for the quilt to be eligible for a prize. The prize is only awarded to the quiltmaker entrant but your quilter will receive acknowledgment and a certificate.
 - Note: If you are an Amateur and your quilt has been commercially quilted you must enter Category 14.
 - Note: If you are a Professional and your quilt has been quilted by another Professional you may enter your quilt in Category 14, in your own name or you may enter your quilt in another Professional or Open Category, in joint names.
- 16. Although the quilt does not need to be completed when submitting your Entry Form, a good quality 10 x 15cm photograph showing the entire quilt (up to whatever stage it is at) is required. The photograph must be labelled with the name of the quilt, and the entrant's name and address. Please also mark hanging direction on the photograph, i.e. 'top' of quilt.
- 17. Quilt dimensions must be stated in centimetres. Accurate measurement is essential. Incorrectly measured quilts may not be hung. Neither width nor length of any one quilt, or set of quilts together, may exceed 290cm. A set of quilts that forms a unified piece may be considered as one entry.
- 18. All quilts must be provided with a sleeve on the back, with a minimum finished depth of 8cm. If the quilt is wider than 200cm, a centre split in the hanging sleeve is advised to allow extra support for the quilt and hanging rod.

- 19. A label stating the name and address of the entrant and the name of the quilt must be securely sewn onto the back of the quilt. The name and address of the entrant must be clearly marked on the bag in which the quilt is sent.
- 20. Interstate entries must include return postage (stamps). All quilts sent by mail and those that are to be returned by mail must arrive in a sturdy, reusable container which meets with postal standards. The Guild reserves the right to charge any member for such a container if it is not provided. Rolled quilts will not be accepted by Australia Post. **All quilts** will be folded as part of the exhibition process.
- 21. Solely for the purposes of judging at this exhibition a Professional (Advanced) Quiltmaker or Quilter is defined as someone who:
 - Has won Best of Show or has won 2 or more Blue Ribbons/Excellence in Quilting Awards in a major show.
 - Å major show is a State/Territory Guild's judged exhibition or competition; or a National/International judged exhibition or competition.
 - Has financial involvement, teaches or publishes in the field of quilting.
 - Including 5 magazine articles in one calendar year or a career total of 10 magazine articles.
 - Sells, designs or participates in making quilts for ongoing financial gain.
 - Financial gain is defined as any amount above the cost of creating the quilt, cost of creating any article, design, teaching aids including samples, notes and travelling expenses.
- 22. The Committee has the final say in deciding an entrant's Amateur or Professional status. Having exhibited as a Professional, Amateur status cannot be resumed.
- 23. Any exhibitor entering a winning quilt as an Amateur and who is found to be of Professional status will forfeit their award and prize even after the event.
- 24. To be eligible for the **Best Quilt Inspired by**an Antique Quilt Award, the quilt must be
 inspired by a quilt made before 1940. You must
 show evidence that you have drafted the quilt
 yourself and not used a commercial pattern.
 You must supply an image of the antique quilt
 which inspired your quilt entry; details of
 where it has been sourced; and details of the
 process you used to arrive at the final design.
 Please note the word 'inspired' means that it
 doesn't have to be a complete replica of the
 antique quilt.
- 25. Colour is an essential tool for excellence in quilts. In awarding the **Creative Use of Colour Award** consideration will be given to how the colour choices made by the quiltmaker contribute to the overall balance of the quilt and how colour has been used to give the quilt its unique visually emotive and personal look. All judged quilts are eligible for this award.
- 26. The **Best Use of Dyes and Pigments Award** is open to any entrant from Categories 1-15 where they have firstly dyed, coloured and/or discharged the fabric themselves and this fabric

- covers at least 20% of the quilt top. Please include details of the products and processes that you used and indicate if this was done in a workshop, etc.
- 27. To be eligible for the **Best Hand Made Quilt Award** the quilt must have been constructed entirely by hand (without the use of a sewing machine) with the exception that the binding may be made and attached by machine.
- 28. To be considered for the **Domestic Machine Quilting Awards**, the quilt must be quilted
 (by the quiltmaker) on a Domestic / Mid Arm
 Machine that is stationary and the quilt moves
 through the machine.
- 29. To be considered for the **Long Arm Machine Quilting Award**, the quilt may be quilted
 (by the quiltmaker) on any style of machine
 and frame system, where the quilt is stationary
 (on a frame) and it is the machine that moves
 over the quilt during the quilting process.
 Please attach a statement detailing your
 quilting process; stating make and model of
 machine/quilting system, whether the method
 used was freehand or computer assisted, and
 acknowledging the designer of any quilting
 patterns used.
- 30. Any quilt selected as **BEST OF SHOW** must be available to tour Australia and New Zealand in 2015. If you have received a Best of Show award in another State/Territory, please inform the Guild immediately. A quilt awarded Best of Show in another State/Territory is not eligible for this award but is eligible for a Category Award. If this quilt is sold, it must be sold under the condition that it be available to tour in 2015. The quiltmaker must be an Australian Resident to win Best of Show.
- 31. The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc. is not liable for any loss, damage or destruction of exhibition items however such loss, damage or destruction is caused, including any negligent act or omission, fault or cause. Insurance cover, if desired, is the responsibility of the quiltmaker.
- 32. The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc. reserves the right to photograph your quilt for our records and to use those photographs for publicity and other appropriate purposes such as in our quarterly newsletter, on our website and blog and a photographic book which may be available for sale to the public. Reports may also appear in various patchwork and quilting online and print publications. Visitors to the exhibition are also permitted to photograph the quilts for personal use.
- 33. The Judges' decision is **final** and no correspondence will be entered into.


