ENTRY CONDITIONS

By signing the accompanying form, you indicate you accept the following conditions

1. ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to all quilters.

2. YOUR QUILT

For the purpose of this exhibition a quilt is defined as a layered stitched textile with at least 2 distinct layers bound together by stitches throughout the piece.

Entries must be the original, non-traditional design of the entrant. Works made under supervision in a class or workshop are **not eligible**.

Quilts must have been completed since January 2008.

Quilts must not have been exhibited nor published in any media previously.

Entrants may submit up to 2 quilts, sets of quilts are considered as a single unit. Only one quilt per entrant will be selected.

Quilts may be any shape or size.

Quilts must be received ready to hang, with a rod pocket with a depth of 10 cm attached to the back top edge of the quilt and finishing 1cm short of the side edges.

All quilts must have a cloth label with the entrant's name, address, phone #, email address and quilt title securely sewn to the back of the quilt.

Quilts may be for sale. A commission of 33.3% will be retained.

3. PHOTOGRAPHY

Images of incomplete quilts will not be accepted.

Selection will be made from high resolution digital images on CD (not DVD). Entrants must submit 2 images of each quilt, one of the whole piece and a detail. Please include your name and the quilt title in the file name. The image should be at least 500 pixels across.

4. TO SUBMIT ENTRY

A non-refundable entry fee of \$25 for members of The Quilters Guild, \$35 for non members must accompany your images and completed entry form. The fee covers up to 2 quilts.

5. SELECTION

Selection will be made on the basis of originality and innovative use of the medium. The selectors' decision is final and no discussion or correspondence will be entered into.

Entrants whose work has been accepted will be notified by email and informed of delivery instructions.

6. TRANSPORTATION AND INSURANCE OF QUILTS

Selected artists will be responsible for the cost of packaging, freight and insurance and all other charges incurred in the delivery and return of quilts. Unless other arrangements are made, quilts will be returned COD by Australia Post.

7. INSURANCE AT THE VENUE

Quilts will be insured at The Manly Art Gallery & Museum for the duration of the exhibition.

8. REPRODUCTION AND RETENTION OF IMAGES

Manly Art Gallery & Museum and The Quilter' Guild of NSW Inc reserve the right to reproduce in any medium, the image of any selected quilt and any text provided by the exhibitor, for publicity, catalogues and any other appropriate purposes.

Manly Art Gallery & Museum and The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc reserve the right to retain a digital record on CD or by any other means, of images of selected quilts, plus text provided by the exhibitor, for archival, educational, promotional or any other appropriate purposes.

Manly Art Gallery & Museum and The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc will not be responsible for royalty payments for photographs reproduced in any medium, before, during or after the exhibition.

9. COPYRIGHT

Manly Art Gallery & Museum and The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc will not be responsible for any damage or loss suffered by any person or organization due to infringement of copyright.
