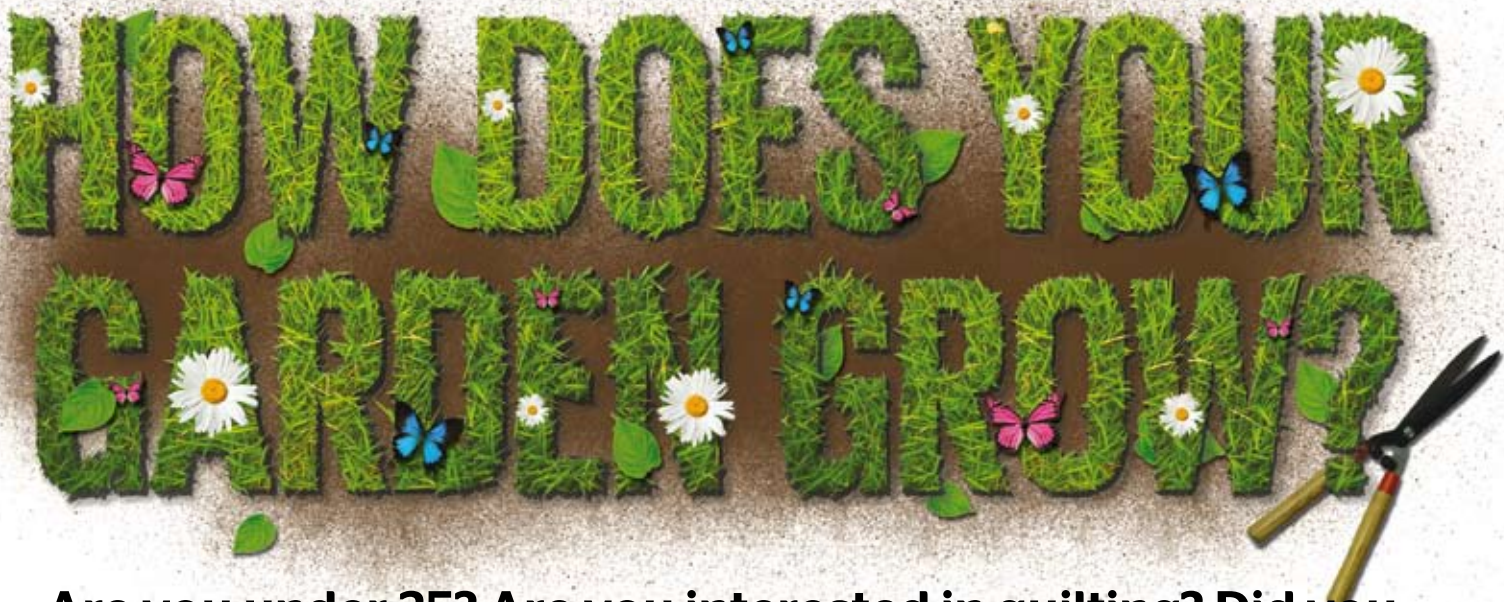

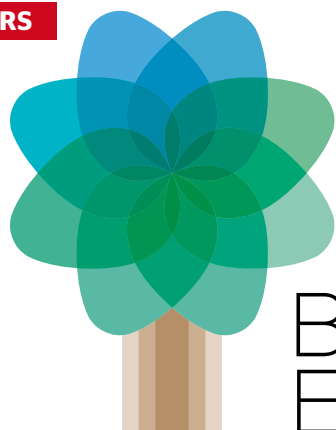

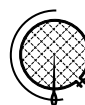

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

(Please read carefully and sign the acknowledgment on the entry form)

- This competition is open to all quiltmakers. It is not compulsory for any exhibitors to be a member of any state Quilting Guild.
- ***Professional quiltmaker:** Someone who teaches or publishes in the field of quilt making, sells designs or participates in making quilts for ongoing financial gain** and/or has won Best of Show or two blue ribbons in any major judged competition***, excluding viewer's choice.
- ****Financial gain:** Any amount above the cost of creating the quilt, cost of creating any article, design, teaching aids, including samples.
- *****Major judged competition:** A state or territory guild, judged exhibition or competition, a national or international competition or exhibition.
- One form is to be completed for each quilt submitted. Copies of the form will be accepted.
- One quilt may be submitted per entrant.
- A quilt may be entered in only one of the listed categories. Please choose your category with care.
- Please read this form carefully and fill in every section. Failure to do so may result in your entry not being accepted.
- Any method of construction can be used.
- If a quilt is made by more than one person it is considered as one entry.
- All entrants must comply with the age category conditions of entry.
- Entrants can interpret the theme literally; traditional or contemporary. Pictorial or traditional designs.
- A quilt is defined as having three layers held together at regular intervals and must be capable of being hung. Quilts must not be framed in wood, metal etc.
- The finished size of the quilt must not exceed 120cm x 150cm. Size must be stated in centimetres, accurate measurement is essential. A set of quilts may not exceed the maximum size and will be seen as one entry.
- A hanging sleeve to be attached to the back of the quilt and should be 6cm deep and sewn to the top back edge of the quilt.
- The quilt must be the original work, including piecing, quilting and binding.
- One colour photograph or printed image of the entrant with their quilt must accompany each entry form. Please mark the photograph or printed image with the entrant's name and the quilt name. Hardcopy photographs will not be returned to the entrant. Please indicate the top of the

quilt in the photograph or printed image.

- Prizes will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd & 3rd placements in each category.
- Awards and prizes will be forfeited if any entrant's information is found to be incorrect.
- The judges' decision is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
- Closing date for the competition is September 12, 2012. This date must strictly be adhered to. All quilts must be sent to the address given. Failure to comply with these instructions could mean disqualification.
- All quilts sent by mail must arrive in a sturdy, reusable container that meets postal standards.
- Rolled quilts will not be accepted. ALL quilts will be folded as part of the exhibition process.
- Universal Magazines, Brother, and The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc. accept no responsibility for any loss, damage or destruction of items, however caused, during transit or while items remain in their custody. Insurance cover, if desired, is responsibility of the entrant.
- Universal Magazines, Brother, and The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc. reserve the right to photograph or permit to be photographed or recorded, any or all items for records, publication and for any other appropriate purposes. The entrant further grants to Universal Magazines, Brother, and The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc. a licence to produce, reproduce and publish the entrant's submission, which may be used in articles, ads, promotions, books, websites, and/ or multimedia productions for and about *Quilters Companion* magazine, the Guild newsletter *The Template*, or any publication of Universal Magazines, Brother, or The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc.
- The quiltmaker is responsible for obtaining written permission and for paying any fee related to the use of copyright material, including trademarks. A copy of permission must accompany the quilt.
- All quilts must be completed in the previous 12 months and be in clean order and condition. Universal Magazines, Brother, and The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc. reserve the right to reject any quilt that does not comply.
- Overseas entrants must pre-pay for return postage on quilts.
- All quilts will be exhibited at the "How Does Your Garden Grow?" show sponsored by Newington College and The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc., which will be held September 21-23, 2012.
- Visitors to the exhibition are permitted to take photographs for personal use only.
- All quilts will be returned to entrants in December 2012.
